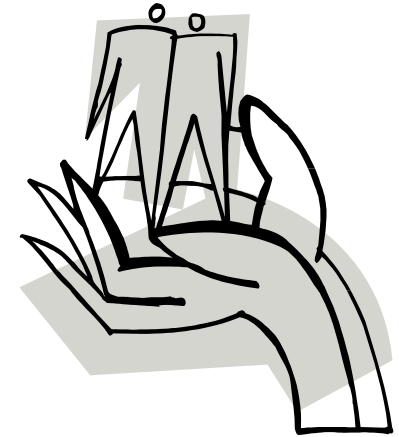

OUR MISSION

The Mid-South Substance Abuse Commission's purpose is to develop and administer a comprehensive plan to obtain and provide resources that prevent and reduce the misuse and abuse of Alcohol and Other Drugs.

It is our goal to assure the availability of comprehensive, quality services in the areas of prevention, intervention, assessment, and substance use disorder treatment in the Mid-South region.

WHAT WE DO

The Mid-South Substance Abuse Commission was formed pursuant to Public Act 368, as amended 1978 and the 2007 Intercounty Agreement between Clinton, Eaton, Gratiot, Hillsdale, Ingham, Ionia, Jackson, Lenawee, and Newaygo Counties' Board of Commissioners. Some functions and activities of the Commission are as follows:

- Develop comprehensive plans for substance use disorder treatment, rehabilitation, and prevention services in the region.

- Management of Medicaid funds for recipients' access to substance use disorder treatment services in partnership with the region's Prepaid Inpatient Health Plans.
- Provide technical assistance for the contracted substance use disorder treatment service organizations.
- Collect and transfer data and financial information from local organizations to MDCH/BSAAS
- Make and monitor contracts necessary and incidental to the Commission's annual performance goals.
- Annually evaluate and assess substance use disorder treatment services in the region to ensure the needs of the community are being addressed.
- Engage local communities in the establishment of Prevention Coalitions to use data-driven decision making to reach prevention outcomes. Communities utilize local, regional, state, and national data to identify needs, develop plans, and allocate resources.
- Fund "Outcome Based" prevention programs. It is paramount to have the ability to evaluate and measure our effectiveness in providing prevention services within the Mid-South region.
